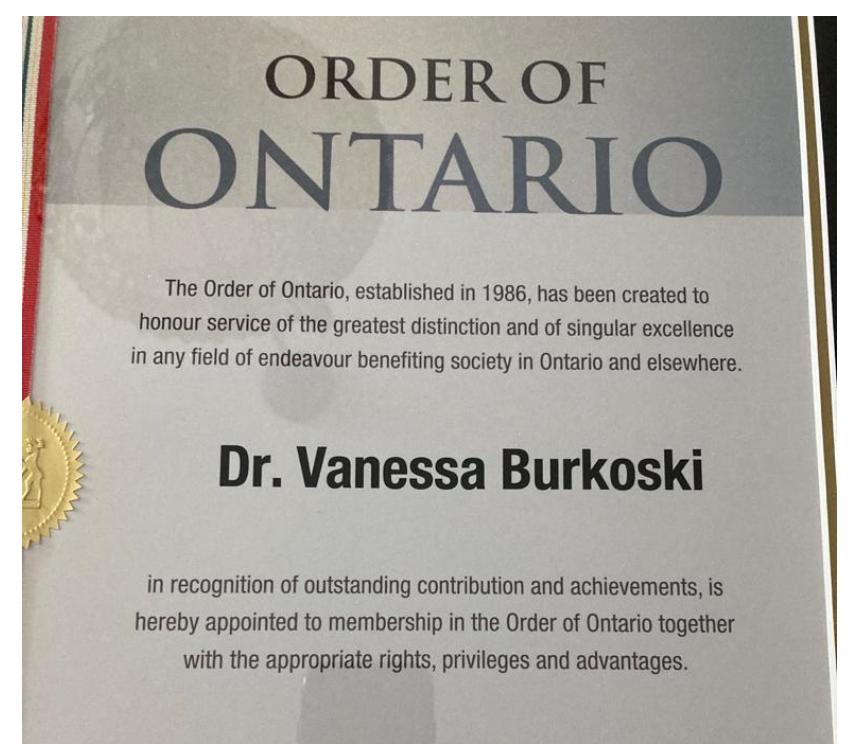


Dr. Vanessa Burkoski – Appointee to the Order of Ontario

First Abbott Aveir Leadless Pacemaker Implant at Humber - June 22

On June 22, Dr. Irving Tiong implanted Humber's first Abbott Aveir Leadless Pacemaker with the assistance of our organized and professional laboratory team. Humber is one of nine centers across Canada and second in Ontario to implant a commercially available Aveir Leadless Pacemaker.

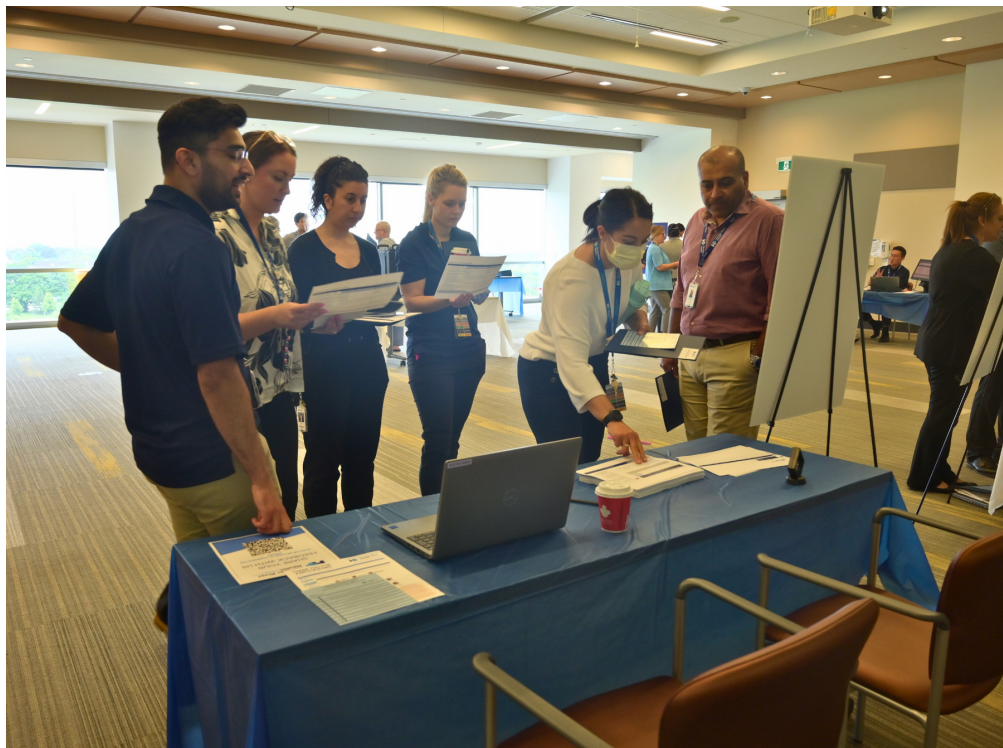
The Aveir Pacemaker has no lead and is screwed directly into the heart, which decreases the risk of infection, eliminates arm movement restrictions post implant, eliminates complications related to a lead fracture, and is fully retrievable if the device requires replacement.
