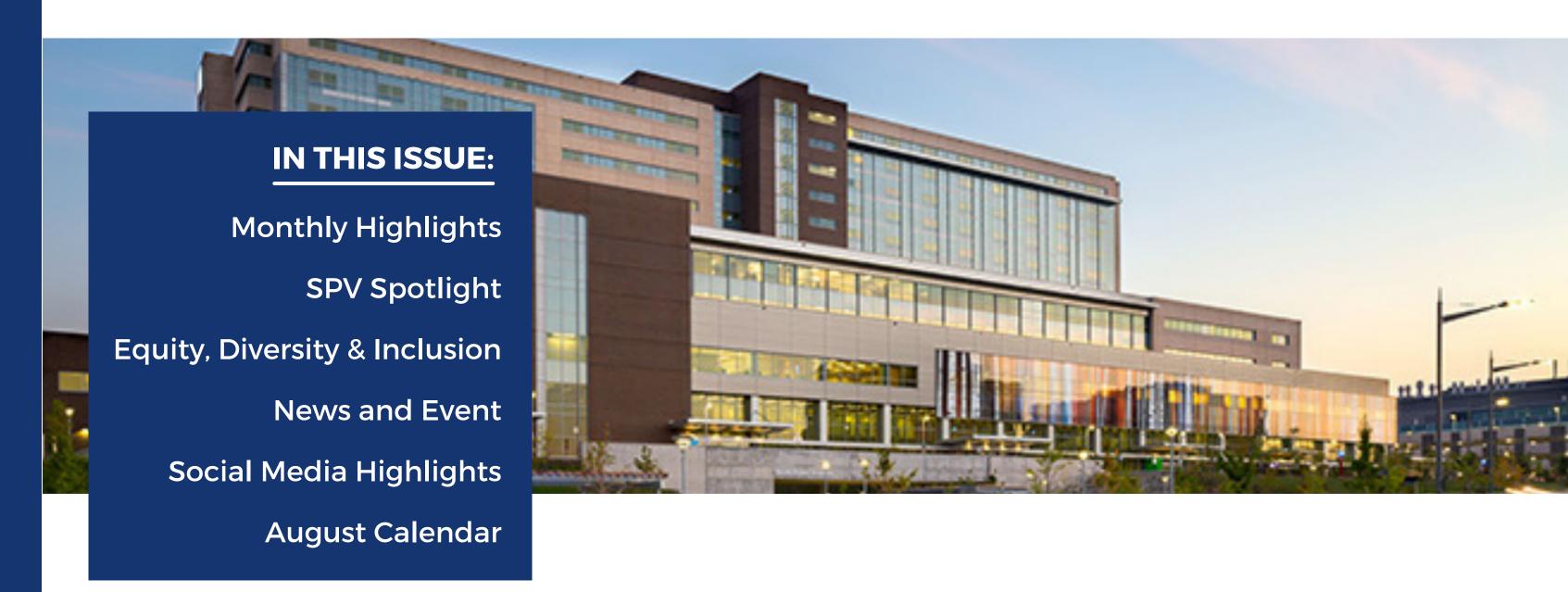

Humber River Health Reveals COVID Wall of Fame

On July 13, Humber River Health revealed our COVID Wall of Fame, generously donated by Terry and Mary Jo Leon. The COVID Wall of Fame is a permanent showcase within the Hospital, comprised of engraved names of the staff, physicians and volunteers who worked tirelessly during the pandemic between March 17, 2020 to May 9, 2022, the date the City of Toronto's COVID-19 emergency declaration ended.

According to Toronto Public Health, Humber's Northwestern Toronto community experienced the highest burden of COVID-19. During this time, Humber provided care to 4,000 inpatients admitted with the virus and provided COVID lab tests for 123,000 patients.

This display is one of the ways we are able to show our appreciation for the compassion our teams brought to patients throughout COVID-19, and the dedication they continue to display in delivering integrated care and **Lighting New Ways in Healthcare** everyday.

To all the staff, physicians, and volunteers at Humber River Health, thank you for all you do!

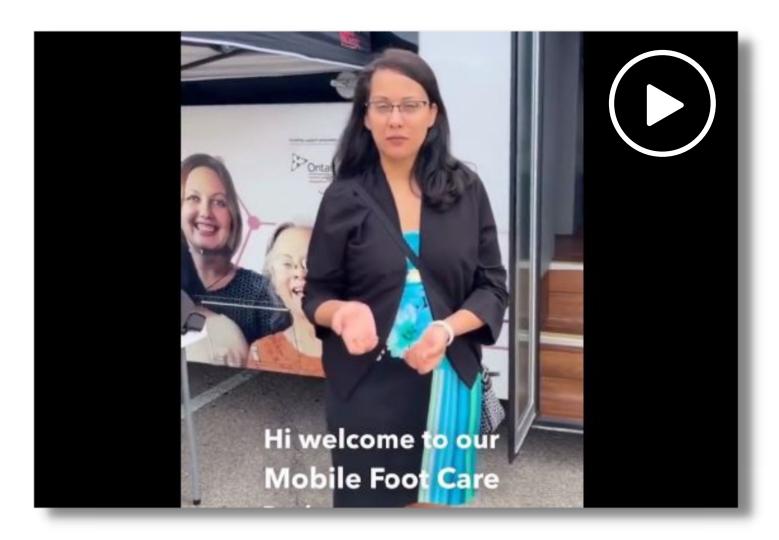

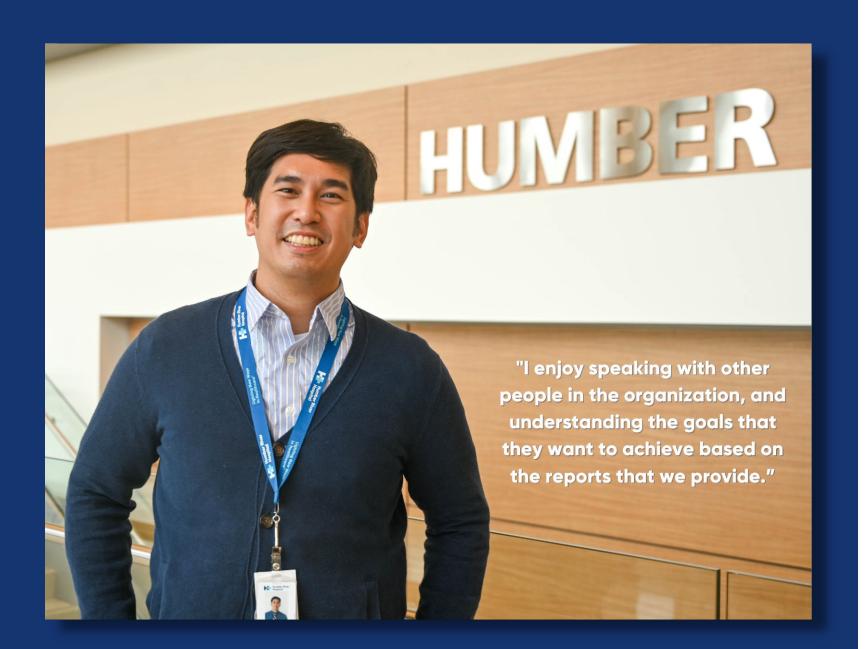
Finance Team

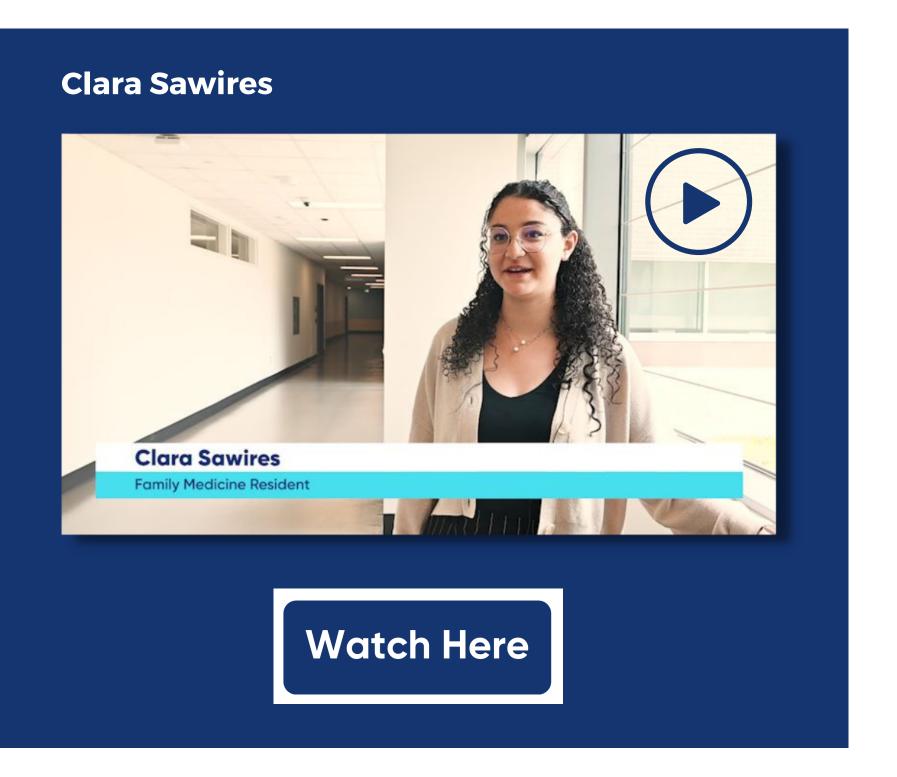

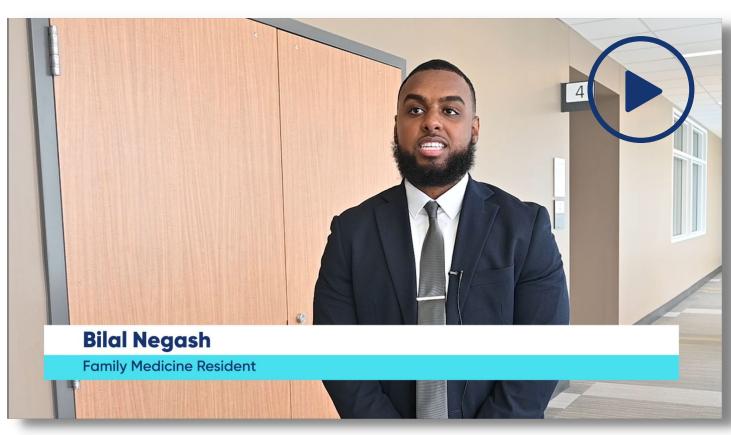
Schulich Family Medicine Teaching Unit Residents

Black Leaders Awareness Day - July 18

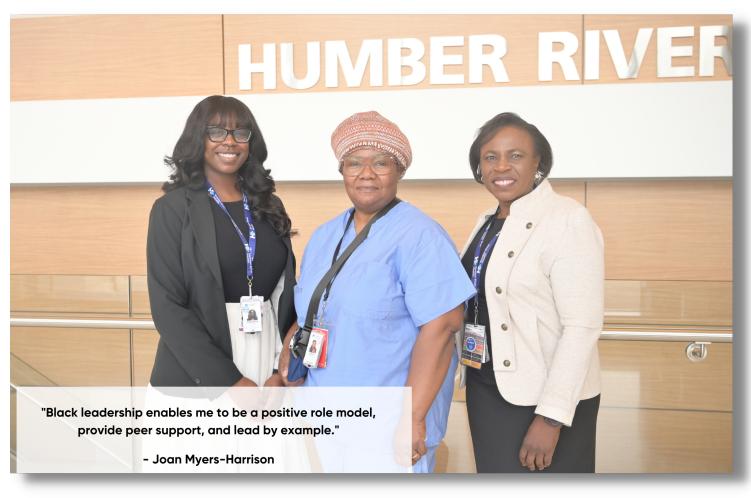

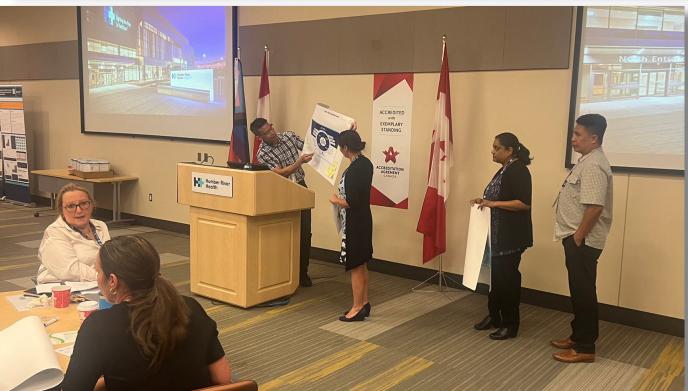
Leadership Forum - July 12

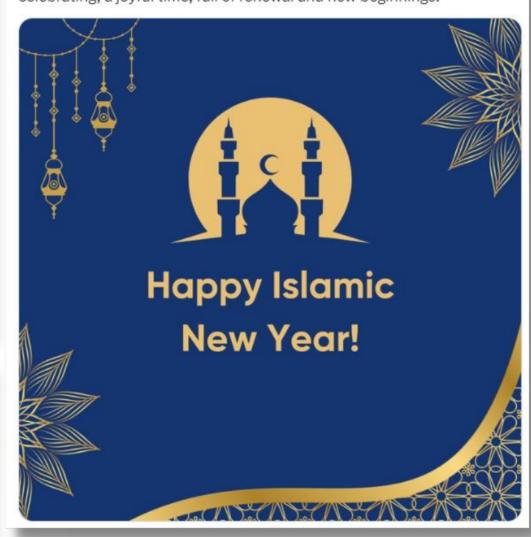
