
Dr. Art Kushner - Retirement as Chief of Family & Community Practice














Foundation Update

MAY 9

Feast of the Ascension happens forty days after Jesus' resurrection and is the anniversary of Jesus' ascension into heaven.

MAY 19

Pentecost commemorates the coming of the Holy Spirit upon the disciples of Jesus as found in (Acts. 2:1-11).

MAY 26

Lag Ba'Omer commemorates the death of Rabbi Shimon Bar Yochai, who is the Jewish sage and author of the Kabbalah.

MAY 23

Declaration of Bab is a Bahai celebration to commemorate His identity as Bab or Gate, the Herald of the New Age.

Vesak (Budda Day) is the beginning of Lunar New Year and celebrates Siddhartha Gautamal and his ancient Buddhist teachings on compassion and peace.

Saga Dawa Düchen is the day in the Tibetan tradition that celebrates Buddha's birth, enlightenment, and paranirvana on the Tibetan Lunar Calendar.

MAY 28

Ascension of Baha'u'llah commemorates the anniversary of the death of the founder of the Bahai faith.



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
